Discovering potential at Mining & Construction Vietnam

Vietnam's Mining and Construction Sectors are undergoing a significant transformation, laying the foundation for the nation's future industrialization. Vietnam's Mining Industry: Huge Untapped Market

Vietnam has some 50 kinds of minerals and 5,000 operating mines. The mining industry makes up nearly 5 percent of the country's GDP, according to statistics published by the Vietnam Minerals Department under the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MoNRE).

Despite the great potential of natural resources, Vietnamese firms still need access to deep processing technology. Due to the difficulties of obtaining processing technologies, firms only complete 40% of the processing required to make rare earth usable.

Resolution - 10-NQ/TW sets out the objectives by 2045 as follows: To complete 100% of the formulation of mineral and geological maps at the scale of 1:50,000, for land areas and 1:500,000 for the sea; To complete the basic survey of other geological resources; To complete the advanced and modern mining industry in association with the circular economy and green economy model corresponding to advanced countries in Asia.

In addition to promoting the growth of the mineral industry, the Vietnamese government places a strong emphasis on minimizing environmental damage. The Mineral Law issued by the Vietnamese government serves as the cornerstone for long-term change, steering the sector toward sustainability and ensuring that Vietnam's mineral resource extraction does not harm the environment.

Key projects, such as the bauxite and aluminum mining operations in Đắk Nông province, underscore Vietnam's ambition to become a significant player in the global mineral market. These efforts, driven by both state-owned and private enterprises, are in response to the country's increasing demand for construction materials and the expansion of its infrastructure base.

Prospects of Vietnam's Construction Industry

Vietnam's construction industry is experiencing a boom, with projected growth rates expected to exceed 6% annually from 2025 to 2028. The primary drivers of this development are the government's ambitious infrastructure plans, such as expanding the national highway network to 5,000 kilometers by 2030 and constructing numerous metro lines in major cities like Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi. These infrastructure projects not only elevate Vietnam's transportation network but also create substantial opportunities for both domestic and international investors. Additionally, the government's commitment to building one million social housing units by 2030 further underscores the scale and potential of the construction industry in the coming years.

The synergy between Vietnam's mining and construction sectors is creating a dynamic environment where these industries not only support but also reinforce each other. The extraction of minerals, essential for building materials, is closely linked with the country's infrastructure development. This interdependent relationship ensures that as Vietnam continues to build its future, growth will be both sustainable and economically advantageous.

With government leadership and a favorable investment climate, Vietnam is positioning itself as a leader in sustainable industrial development. Integrating modern technologies and practices across these sectors will play a pivotal role in shaping Vietnam's economic landscape by 2030 and beyond.
