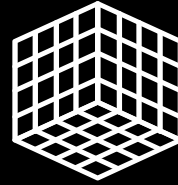

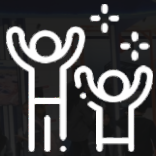

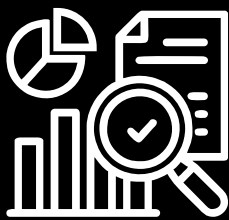

3. Consistently calculate carbon footprint by implementing survey to encourage active participation in emission reduction efforts.
4. In partnership with Ecoloop and Jangjo, executed a waste management programme that enhanced recycling efficiency and promoted responsible waste practices.
5. Continued collaboration with Pureve in providing Water Refill Stations to consistently reduce single-use plastic waste.
6. Developed VEXPO (Virtual Expo), an online platform for exhibitors, networking, and seminars accessible worldwide.
7. Enhanced the Better Stand Programme by encouraging the wider use of modular, reusable exhibition structures.
8. Consistently promoted eco-certified hotels (GSTC and SHA members) as part of the annual commitment to sustainable accommodation practices.
9. Collaborated with universities and exhibitors through the "Connecting the Disconnected" initiative and the Student Visit Programme to support future engineers and foster interest in the energy and engineering industries.
10. Launched the IEE Run for Charity 2025, a 5K fun run supporting student scholarships and featuring participation from disabled running communities.
11. Maintained the SHARE PIE programme by PJCI to empower and connect young innovators in the sustainable energy sector.
12. The Resilient & Response Hub showcases innovative university projects on resilience and disaster response, fostering collaboration among academics, communities and industry.
13. Delivered a series of sustainability content aligned with UN SDGs, including Energy Talk, BIM Talk, Oil & Gas Talk, Mining Talk, and other hybrid seminar series.
14. Collaborated with local partners (Organic Juicery & Perfect Health) to provide wellbeing support and facilities throughout the event series.
15. In partnership with Kopi Sunyi and BPJS Ketenagakerjaan to promote inclusivity and provide opportunities for people with disabilities.
16. Partnered with local SMEs (Saktah Kopi, Dus Duk Duk, etc) to strengthen sustainability initiatives and creative industry collaborations.
17. Partnered with Repair Project and Rappo to produce upcycled merchandise made from various waste materials, including repurposed banners from IEE Series 2024.
18. Strengthened collaboration with NGOs for impactful initiatives such as mangrove planting (Lindungihutan x Dus Duk Duk), clean water and education (Happy Hearts Indonesia, Menjadi Indonesia Pintar, Benih Baik), and health support (YKAKI).
